OTHER INFORMATION

Hotel accommodation based on 4 players per room. Players housed 2 to a room in residence halls. Free room for Head Coach and one assistant. Teams can register as commuters and make their own arrangements. Teams provide their own transportation. The fields are a 10 minute drive from the residence halls and hotels.

To apply, send in the application on the left with a \$100 team deposit. Coaches can also register their team online. This reserves your school's place in camp and is refunded at the end of camp (or can be applied to camper fees.)

You will receive a roster sheet. Fill out, collect \$50 deposits (or full fee) from players and return. Balances, if any, are due at registration in July.

Andy Smyth, Head Men's Soccer Coach at The University of Findlay. Smyth holds the UEFA 'A' license, USSF 'A' License, NSCAA Premier Diploma. He has directed and coached camps for more than 30 years. This will be the twenty seventh, successful year of the high school team camp.
